## >> Argentina



With the Ministry of Public Works, **11 modular hospitals** are being installed in **4 provinces**



**798** hospital beds and intensive

Procurement of **respirators, masks and diagnostic kits** for Buenos Aires City council

With White Helmets Commission, **procurement of protection and hygiene items**



With the Public Prosecutor's Office for Labour: delivery of **10 multiparameter monitors** in Florianopolis

**Protective equipment** for health personal in Santa Catarina

Support to the Water and Sanitation Institute and to the Ministry of Housing & Human Settlements to ensure water provision in informal settlements

Acquisition of prevention supplies for UN System entities.



Delivery of the **San Miguel Regional Hospital** to the national Social Security Institute, which due to the crisis will be used as a response to COVID-19

UNOPS has built and equipped the Hospital with **+200 beds**, benefiting **220,000 beneficiaries** in 4 departments.

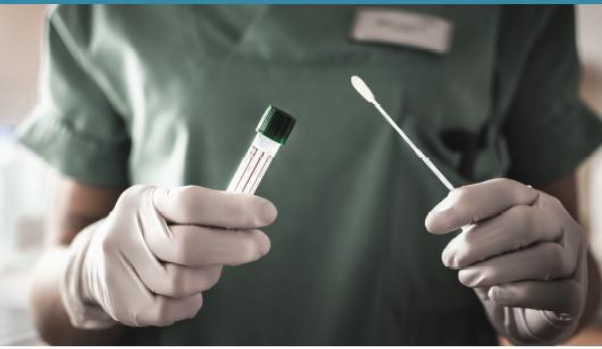

Along with the IGSS acquisition of **10,000 tests for detection of COVID-19 and 36 items of medical equipment.**

Purchase of **clinical furniture, surgical materials and protection kits** for doctors and nurses from IGSS.

Delivery of **74 types of essential medicines** for patients suspected or positive for coronavirus.



## >> Peru



With the Peruvian government, procurement of **personal protective equipment and medical devices** to deal with COVID-19



Rehabilitation and equipment of **Hospital Delmas 2**, which was adequate to treat COVID-19

## >> Haiti

Delivery of medical **equipment to 2 centers**, including 150 beds and clinical furniture

Support to procurement coordination for the **UNCT**

## >> Paraguay



Together with Itaipu Binacional and the Ministry of Health: **purchase of ventilators, multi-parameter monitors and clinical furniture**

Supplies for **500 people** to carry out health quarantine



Support for the creation of **50 rural micro-enterprises** for food production



Acquisition of food kits for **+5000 families**



UNOPS manages the facilities of the **Regional Logistics Center for Humanitarian Aid**, in order to guarantee its continuous operation, this allows humanitarian agencies to give an effective response in LAC
